#### CLEANING CARE GUIDE

Only use a mild soap and water for cleaning. Rinse with water to remove the mild soap solution. We recommend the product is dried using a soft cloth after every use.

Never use any abrasive or strong cleaning products containing, bleaches, acids (hydrochloric, formic, phosphorus, chlorine or acetic), strong detergents, limescale remover, alcohol or dyes etc. Never use abrasive cleaning pads, wire wool or microfibre cloths. Never use cleaning equipment that may have been pre-used and contaminated with the above substances.

**Never** apply the cleaning product directly onto the finished surface.


















#### **BEFORE INSTALLATION**



It is recommended to avoid installation of dispenser near high reflective objects (mirror, stainless steel washbasins, etc.) in order to avoid faulty function of the presence sensor.

If it is installed near a washbasin and 250MM from dispenser's bottom to the basin desk is required.




#### **BEFORE INSTALLATION**


Provide vertical, clean and smooth mounting surface. Make sure there is enough room above dispenser to access cover lock key. Ensure there are no obstructions below unit in sensor range. Check operation of unit while holding in place by hand BEFORE permanent installation


#### INSTALLATION


Drill four [4] holes as following diagram of  $\Phi$ 6x18MM [15/64" Dia.x 45/64"] deep if using wall anchors supplied with unit. Install supplied anchors flush with wall face, or install other fastening system suitable for wall conditions (not supplied). Attach dispenser] to wall.

For the first time use or long time no use, please active the sensor by hand around 5 times in order to clean the air in pipe.

### TROUBLE SHOOTING

SYMPTOM	CORRECTIVE ACTION
No soap dispensed on hands	Check soap qualities, properties and level in soap/sanitizer tank. Check sensor cover for dirt obscuring the lens. Check battery charge level. Check spout nozzle, soap dispensing tube for clogs. Check if the ON/OFF lever [ Installation "7" ] at right location. Check if the soap tank locates at right hanging bracket [ Installation "3"]. Active the dispenser sensor several times for the first time use or long time no use the dispenser. Some soap [ Sanitizer ] is blocked the pipe if lone time without use the dispenser.
Low volume soap dispensed	Remove soap tank & wash out spout nozzle, clean dispense tube by water. Check if the tube is loose without cross-threaded.
Soap leaks	Check if the soap tank leakage. Check if dispense tube connection loose. Check disposable soap pump for defects and/or replace.

#### WARRANTY

All of our dispensers are designed and manufactured to provide years of dependable performance. Component parts are guaranteed to be free of defects in material and workmanship for a period of one (1) ear from date of original invoice. This guarantee will be honored provided that the dryer is installed and maintained in accordance with the instructions. Parts damaged during the installation are the purchaser's responsibility. The warranty covers defects exclusively, and only liability for the replacement of defective parts will be accepted. This warranty does not cover wear and tear, or misuse and abuse. Transportation, freight cost and labor are also excluded. Defective parts must be returned prepaid, accompanied by the serial number, to the point of purchase. This warranty is granted solely to the original purchaser of the unit and is subject to registration.

# MAINTENANCE


Soap dispensers located in low traffic areas should have the soap dispenser valves wiped down to remove any air-hardened soap residue left on the nozzle spouts. This should be done as part of the day-to-day janitorial maintenance routine covering them. General cleaning on a regular schedule is adequate for soap dispensers in higher traffic areas, with no special attention required.

#### General cleaning tips

Apply neutral detergents formulated for these purposes (non-ionic surfactants and citric acid). Apply the detergent with soft cloth. Be careful with abrasive cloths. They may scratch the surface. Rinse with water until all the detergent has gone.

Residue from hygiene products, liquid soap, shampoos, bath gel, etc, can also damage surfaces. Rinse the surface with plenty of water after use.

Limescale stains can be prevented by drying the surface with a soft cloth after use.




# Specific cleaning tips

Limescale from mains water: Apply a solution of one part vinegar and three parts water directly to the stains and leave to work for a few minutes. Then rub with a soft cloth or damp sponge. Then give it a final wash with plenty of water and neutral soap to ensure it is thoroughly rinsed. Unacceptable practices (loss of guarantee)

- Do not apply detergents with abrasive products or which contain: Hydrochloric acid Sodium hypochlorite (bleach) Formic acid.
- o not use abrasive utensils like metal sourcing pads or abrasive sponges.
- o not spray the detergent on the surface, because the liquid can get into the openings or cracks in them and cause damage.
- o not use anti-limescale and descaling cleaning products.
- o not use silver cleaners, contain chlorides.


