


CLEANING CARE GUIDE

Only use a mild soap and water for cleaning. Rinse with water to remove the mild soap solution. We recommend the product is dried using a soft cloth after every use.

Never use any abrasive or strong cleaning products containing, bleaches, acids (hydrochloric, formic, phosphorus, chlorine or acetic), strong detergents, limescale remover, alcohol or dyes etc. **Never** use abrasive cleaning pads, wire wool or microfibre cloths. **Never** use cleaning equipment that may have been pre-used and contaminated with the above substances.


Never apply the cleaning product directly onto the finished surface.





Preparation Before Installation





To install a single-function shower, hit a sink (outlet sink 3). To install a two-function shower, use two outlets (outlet 1 and outlet 2). Install a three-function shower, then play three out of the sink (outlet sink 1, sink 2, drain 3).




Recommended opening size: Figure a is the length and width of the hole, Figure b shows the depth from the bottom of the hole to the finished wall.

Installation a Wall Box








Secure the box to the wall with 4 expansion screws and tighten with the wrench, and make sure the box is parallel to the wall; observe the level on the box, pay attention to whether the box is installed horizontally; indicates upwards in the figure


Connecting hot and cold inlet and outlet pipes

Note: Before connecting, please turn on the water source first, rinse the impurities in the water pipe, and then turn off the water source after washing.


Sealed Wall



After rinsing and ensuring that there is no leakage inside, fill the surrounding wall with cement.





The effect of cement filling. .



Stick the tiles and the tiles should match the edges of the box. After the tile is finished, wait for the panel to be installed.


Mounting Panel






To close the water source, first loosen the two hex nuts counterclockwise with the HF005 horseshoe sleeve (12), then use the tool (11) to unscrew the three screws (3) and remove the upper cover (2).


The tile plane is flush, the excess of the buried wall box is cut off, and the glass ring is coated on the entire circle of the box and the wall. Note: 1: Be sure to cut flat to ensure that the panel can be tiled.



10) Place the wall horizontally according to the position shown in figure, and confirm that the valve core is open (up to the highest position). Turn the adjustment joint so that it coincides with the surface 1, and rotate the adjustment screw to coincide with the surface 2. Finally, tighten the hex nut clockwise with the HF005 horseshoe sleeve (12).



Mounting member (4) panel assembly as shown



Install the handle (7), use the tool (9) to install the parts (5), (6) on the handle in turn, and make sure the handle is securely installed.

Cleaning

All surface should be cleaned using a clean damp cloth. No abrasive cleaning agents or materials should be used.
